Ministry Commission Report to Presbytery

October 6–7 Fall Stated Presbytery Meeting

DELEGATED ACTIONS TAKEN BY THE MINISTRY COMMISSION (MC) ON BEHALF OF PRESBYTERY

Pastors examined and recommended by the Ministry Commission to be approved as members of Presbytery of Yukon:

- Recommended that Rev. Blake Severson be welcomed as a member of Presbytery of Yukon as interim pastor of Eagle River Presbyterian Church [June 19, 2023].
- Recommended that Evangelical Church of America (ELCA) pastor, Rev. Erika Bergh be welcomed as a temporary member of the Presbytery of Yukon with voice and vote in the presbytery meetings [June 7] while she is supply pastor at University Community Presbyterian Church.
- Recommended that Korean Presbyterian Church Abroad (KPCA) pastor, Rev. Seongjin Ryu be
 welcomed as a temporary member in the Presbytery of Yukon with voice and vote in presbytery
 meetings [July 27, 2023] while he is supply pastor at Fairbanks Korean Presbyterian Church.

Pastors dismissed to another Presbytery:

- Voted to dismiss Rev. Timothy Baranoski to Pueblo Presbytery [October 5, 2023].
- Voted to dismiss Rev. Alison Burchett to Cimarron Presbytery, if the way be clear [October 5, 2023].

2024 Minimum Terms of Call.

- The MC amended the Presbytery of Yukon's Minimum Terms of Call for called and installed pastors to conform with the 2023-2025 Book of Order. The Book of Order requires that the call includes a minimum of twelve weeks paid family medical leave. [July 27, 2023] The added section is as follows:
 - **Family Leave** up to 12 weeks paid family medical leave. Family Leave is defined as leave to accommodate the birth, foster placement, or adoption of a child; leave to provide care to an ill or disabled family member; and leave to heal following a loss or tragic event.
- The Ministry Commission approved a task force to review minimum terms of call for called and installed Pastors, and to develop minimum terms of call for supply pastors [October 5, 2023].

Administrative Commissions (AC)

- <u>Fairbanks Korean</u>. Reorganized the AC to include elder Jinhee Dickerson (Fairbanks Korean), moderator Seong Hyun Yoo (First Korean, Anchorage), and at least 2 MC members [April 2023]. Voted to add Fairbanks Korean's pastor Rev. Seongjin Ryu as a member of the AC and to move him toward moderating the AC and session when he has received proper PC(USA) polity training [October 5, 2023]
- <u>First Korean, Anchorage</u>. The MC appointed an AC, with members CP Debbie Melton (United Protestant Church), Elder Steve Bang (First Korean Anchorage PC), with Rev. Seung Hyun Yoo serving as moderator. [February 23, 2023]
- <u>Chapel in the Mountains, Anaktuvuk Pass</u>. The MC dissolved the Administrative Commission after the congregation successfully elected a session [July 27, 2023].

Covenant agreements

The MC approved action of the **New Hope Presbyterian Church** session to renew Commissioned Pastor **(CP) Mathieu Tinkelenberg's** Stated Supply Contract for one year, beginning January 1,

2023. This is a part time contract for approximately 20 hours per week [April 12, 2023]. Annual compensation and benefits:

Other

- Vacation Leave; 4 weeks/year. Unused vacation time cannot be cashed out at the end of the year, nor can any be carried over from year to year. If this one-year covenant is not extended for additional years, unused time is lost. Session must approve leave.
- Continuing Education Leave: 2 weeks/year and \$1,500 study leave. CE time and allowance may be banked for no more than a 3-year accumulation.
- Medical leave: 14 days
- Paid Family Medical Leave (FML): up to 8 weeks per event of paid FML may be granted if a significant life event happens to the employee or an immediate family member. Session must approve leave. Significant life events are, but are not limited to: death or debilitation of an immediate family member, significant health condition of the employee or an immediate family member, employee divorce or dissolution, etc.
- Worker's Compensation is required

The MC approved action by the **University Community Presbyterian Church** session to enter into a contract with Evangelical Lutheran Church of America pastor, **Rev. Erika Bergh** as Stated Supply Pastor for one year, beginning June 1, 2023. This is a part time contract for approximately 25 hours per week [June 7, 2023].

The MC approved action of the **Utqiaġvik PC** session to renew **Rev. Joseph Reid's** stated supply contract for one year, beginning March 23, 2023. This is a full-time commitment; however, Pastor Reid will be allowed to work quarterly from Atlanta and from Utqiaġvik as the task or work requires. [July 27, 2023].

Moving expenses also include up to 3,000 pounds of household goods and up to 2,000 pounds of books moved to Barrow at the most economic rate available as well as return of such items from Barrow to Seattle at the end of the term.

* Study leave time and reimbursement may be accrued for no more than 3 years. Study leave may not be used at the end of the contract term.

** Vacation leave does not accumulate. For every second year, the pastor (as a bush pastor) has an additional 2-weeks' vacation and reimbursement for round-trip airfare by published cheapest airfare to Seattle for the pastor and any immediate family residing in the manse. Pastor Reid will have the option of having a solid one-week vacation each quarter, rather than one or two longer vacations.

*** Sick leave: 10 days initially, with additional leave accumulating at a rate of one day/month until there is a total of 90 days.

The MC approved action of the session of the **Korean Presbyterian Church of Fairbanks** to enter into contract with Korean Presbyterian Church Abroad (KPCA) pastor, **Rev. Seongjin Ryu** as stated supply pastor for one year, beginning August 6, 2023. This is a part-time contract for approximately 25 hours per week [July 27, 2023]. Annual compensation and benefits:

Ministers

a. Entered into a temporary pastoral relationship with United Methodist Church (UMC) pastor, **Rev. Charley Brower**, to perform sacraments at PC(USA) churches on the North Slope and at University Community Presbyterian Church, as requested by IAM and by University Community session through February 2024. The relationship will be reviewed annually at the February Ministry Commission meetings [April 23, 2023].

Commissioned Pastors

- Approved commission renewal for CP Joseph Brock for 3 years and reappointed Rev. Leisa Carrick as his pastor mentor [June 7, 2023].
- Determined that Presbytery will pay for CP-in-training Vera Lincoln's flight to Anaktuvuk Pass for Commissioned Pastor polity training [April 12, 2023]. Is working to provide Vera with a Pastor Mentor, as requested (but not required) [October 5, 2023].
- Noted that the 2023 Book of Order makes it clearer that it is allowable for commissioned pastors (CPs) to be commissioned to serve in one or more ministries. For example, more than one church. If CPs and sessions desire to expand the commissioning of a CP, they should approach the Ministry Commission [October 5, 2023]

Churches

New Hope Presbyterian Church

 Approved Elder Cristina Welker to moderate the session, with the understanding that the polity of PC(USA) requires the pastor to be the moderator and that New Hope will work toward the goal of having their pastor or commissioned pastor moderate session after taking PC(USA) polity training [April 12, 2023].

Gambell Presbyterian Church

• Approved elder Deborah Apatiki to moderate session, with the understanding that the polity of PC(USA) requires the pastor or commissioned pastor to be the moderator and that Gambell will work toward the goal of having their moderator take PC(USA) polity training by February 2024, as facilitated by the Ministry Commission [April 12, 2023].

Eagle River Presbyterian Church

- Rev. Leisa Carrick was appointed acting moderator until an interim pastor is hired. UMC pastor, Rev. Todd Carter offered to assist with pastoral care until an interim is in place. Rev. Carrick agreed [April 12, 2023].
- Rev. Tim Carrick will be the Ministry Commission Liaison for the Pastor Nominating Committee (PNC) [April 12, 2023].
- Approved Rev. Blake Severson as interim pastor [June 19, 2023]

- Appointed Rev. Piper Cartland to replace Rev. Alison Burchett as moderator of session [October 5, 2023]

- Released Rev. Rich Mauer as the church moderator [June 7, 2023].

- 1. The stated clerk received word this year that
 - a. The ministry commission received word that Rev. Curt Karns and Rev. Charley Brower celebrated communion and baptized people at the following North Slope churches, as part of their Intergenerational Arctic Ministries (IAM) visits [April and August 2023]
 - i. Kaktovik, Easter April 9: Baptized 16 children and 2 adults.
 - ii. Atgasuk August 20: Baptized 5 children and 3 adults.
 - b. The stated clerk received word that CP Darlene Matz passed away on April 25, 2023 in Anchorage, AK. Darlene served as a lay pastor at Kaktovik Presbyterian Church for many years.
 - c. The stated clerk received word that elder Mark Wartes passed away on January 26, 2023. Mark was an active member of Utqiagvik Presbyterian Church, and was active in many ministries throughout the presbytery.
 - d. The MC noted that the Leadership Team approved funding for Rev. Curt Karns to travel to Chapel by the Mountains in Anaktuvuk Pass every 3 months to lead worship and provide the Lord's Supper.
