Regional Meetings – participants from the two regions will gather at 7:00 pm via Zoom the week preceding presbytery, in accordance to the following schedule:

- Native Ministries Tuesday, February 16. For commissioners from Anchor, Gambell, Savoonga, Kaktovik, Chapel in the Mountains, Kuukpik, Olgonik, Atqasuk Chapel, and Utqiagvik churches, commissioned pastors, and ministers affiliated with these churches.
- **Road System** Thursday, February 18. For ministers and commissioners from churches along the road system and other members of presbytery affiliated with these churches.

Registration: All members of presbytery and invited guests will be required to register for the meetings. Only those individuals who have registered will be provided with the Zoom link and telephone access numbers. Please register by Tuesday, February 9th.

Church elder commissioners: Due to the abbreviated nature of virtual meetings, the amount of time devoted to each commissioner's report will be very limited. Please restrict your responses to no more than **two** minutes and focus on answering the following questions. In light of the theme verse from Colossians 3:12 - 14:

- What are you/congregation wearing these days?
- How is your church reflecting these qualities?

Meeting Schedule - Participants are encouraged to **login 15 minutes** prior to the start of each day's session. The moderator will aim to declare a recess or adjourn on time, but be aware that daily sessions could run over. A detailed presbytery docket (agenda) will be posted on the presbytery's website a minimum of 10 days before the convening of presbytery.
