#### INFORMATION PROVIDED FOR THE RECORD

Ministry Commission delegated actions: (taken since the fall 2020 stated presbytery meeting)

1. Minister Status: The Ministry Commission has the responsibility of reviewing the status of members-at-large annually.

**Rev. Elizabeth Schultz:** Member-at-Large status was renewed for another year, based on Elizabeth's responses in the annual report filed with the Ministry Commission: [Feb. 4, 2021]

### 2. Minister Contracts

The MC concurred with the action of the Immanuel Presbyterian Church session to renew **Rev. Ellen Johnson-Price's** pastoral supply agreement for another year, retroactive to January 1, 2021. This is a part-time position (28 hours/week). [Feb. 4, 2021]

- 3. Commissioned Pastor Commissions up for renewal.
  - Matt Tinkelenberg (New Hope Church): The Ministry Commission approved the request of the church council to renew Matt's commission for three years. Responsibilities granted under this commission: lead worship services and preach the gospel; administer the Lord's Supper; administer the sacrament of Baptism; have a voice and vote in the meetings of presbytery; perform a service of Christian marriage when invited by the council or other responsible minister, and when allowed by the state; perform a service at a funeral; lead worship services and preach the gospel at other local area churches when invited. [Feb 4, 2021]
  - Marjorie Poggas (Jewel Lake Parish): The Ministry Commission approved the request of the church council to renew Marjorie's commission for another three years. Responsibilities granted under this commission: continue to work with the pastor, elders, and staff to: preach the gospel, lead worship, and serve Communion as requested; maintain contact with partner church and report to council and congregation; assist in visitation/contact with visitors, new members, shut-ins, institutionalized members and friends of Jewel Lake Parish, providing pastoral care and communion when appropriate; assist in identifying/acknowledging gifts and calls to mission; facilitate adult [Electronic vote: Feb 16, 2021]

• Paul Bodfish (Atqasuk Chapel): No renewal request was received

#### 4. Miscellaneous Actions

- Certified Jennifer Pottinger ready for examination by presbytery for ordination and permitted her to begin negotiating for service. [Jan. 18, 2021]
- Appointed Rev. Britt Johnston to serve as liaison to First Korean Anchorage's Pastor Nominating Committee. [Nov 19]
- Authorized CP Matt Tinkelenberg permission to pursue training thru the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America's TEEM certificate program. The Theological Education for Emerging Ministries (TEEM) Is an approach crafted to fit the context of a candidate. [Nov. 19]
- Trinity's infant baptism request. Given that pastor Hoffbeck is not ordained as a minister and that Trinity does not have the internet capability to stream live services, it was recommended that the baptism be postponed until elders are trained and the congregation is able to meet in person. # Presbytery of Yukon Administrative Commission Report From Anchor Presbyterian Church February, 2021

In late 2018, the Presbytery of Yukon approved the following action:

- Presbytery of Yukon assume original jurisdiction and appoint Rev. Britt Johnson [sic], Rev. Ian MacInnes-Green, RE Renee Savage, and RE Clyde Kaneshiro to an Administrative Commission (AC) for Anchor PC for a period up to two years, for the purposes of performing the duties of the session as found in G-3.0201; helping the Anchor congregation discern its future direction, and explore possible options in cooperation with Native Ministries.
- That the Ministry Commission be authorized to seek a fifth member, preferably an Alaska Native elder, to serve on the AC and to replace members as needed, and
- That the AC be expected to give a report at each stated meeting of presbytery.

Since May 22, 2019, our Administrative Commission has comprised:

- Rev. Dr. Britton Johnston (Moderator and Clerk of Session)
- Rev. Elizabeth Schultz
- Elder Renee Savage
- Elder Clyde Kaneshiro
- Elder Jenny Alowa

Since the Fall meeting of the Presbytery, the group has met (via Zoom) once, on December 4th.

Notes From the minutes of the meeting on December 4th:

A total of \$200 worth of grocery store gift cards were given to the needy,

The Administrative Commission approved a gift of \$200 for the Irrigoo family to assist with the costs associated with the death of their sister Marilyn.

As the term of the Administrative Commission has now expired, it appears that decisions regarding the future of Anchor Presbyterian Church are in the hands of the presbytery's Ministry Commission.

The members of the AC would like to meet in March to draft a recommendation to the Ministry Commission.

The cash balance for Anchor as of February 17<sup>th</sup> is \$10901.87.
