- 7. Domestic Violence Workshop: Funds held by permission from a GA grant received in December of 2000. \$350.05
- 8. Internship Fund (Mathes): Interest from the Miriam Snow Mathes endowment to be used to help support internships in the Presbytery. (Restricted) \$52,100.93
- 9. Peacemaking: Presbytery's portion of the Peacemaking offering. \$14,658.09
- 10. Y.E.S.: Youth Exploring Service through leadership project. Grants & donations. \$3,433.62
- 11. Youth Triennium: A fund to accumulate money to help send delegates to Triennium every three years. \$16,411.68
- 12. Candidating (Mission Churches): Capped at \$10,000, provides money for candidates and their spouses to travel to mission churches. \$7,840.94
