Call to the Native Ministries Meeting

The annual face-to-face meeting of the Native Ministries Region will meet in Anchorage August 19 and 20. Each church is asked to send one Ruling Elder, plus your CRE(s) or Teaching Elder Pastor, if you have one. Please plan for the meeting to begin with breakfast on Saturday August 19th, and to end after lunch on Sunday the 20th.

The date for this meeting was set by the officers of Native Ministries Committee, Merle Apassingok, Ida Olemaun and Wanda Slwookoo. We have much to consider at this meeting, and a proposed agenda will come soon. In the meantime, Merle Apassingok, the moderator of the Native Ministries Committee asks us to consider the passage of Joshua 7.

In this Bible passage, God called Gideon to assemble an army to face the combined armies of the Amalekites and the Midianites. But then God acted to stop Israel from thinking, "my own hand (and not God's hand) has saved me:" God reduced the number of warriors in Gideon's army from 22,000 to only 300! Only then did God rout the enemy, with that tiny, select group God chose for that moment.

The ministry needs in our villages may seem powerful, but God calls us together to share the wisdom and the strength that God has placed among us. Like Gideon's tiny army, we are the ones God has brought onto our church sessions, and we few are the ones God has chosen for ministry at this moment. This is an important time to come together.

Indeed, we know that great things happen when God calls us together. We saw this in the 1960s when the International Whaling Commission acted to shut down our bowhead whale hunt. It was then that the first delegates to the Alaska Whaling Commission came together to address this threat to our way of life. God blessed their courage and their work for the people of that generation, and for the generations that followed.

As the church of Jesus Christ, our work is at least as important as that was. The spiritual needs in our villages are strong, but God is stronger. We are the ones God is calling at this time. Please consider prayerfully who God would have you send to our meeting in Anchorage in August. We look forward to meeting with you then, as we join together, worship together and plan for our work together, to glorify God.
