## Stepping Up with COVID Arrives



Because of Alaska's geography —especially the lack of roads to so many communities in the state, our villages have been largely insulated from the COVID virus...until just recently.

In the past weeks, several of Alaska's more remote communities have seen COVID-19 begin to make inroads into their communities. In our presbytery, the St. Lawrence Island community of Gambell has been especially hard-hit, with new cases appearing almost daily in the past few weeks.

At last count Gambell, a community with 700 residents, had 23 cases in the community, and a real shortage of places for quarantining patients who test positive for the virus.

Besides deciding to shut down face-to-face worship once again, the church leaders also decided to make their church manse available as a quarantine center. Since Pastors Beulah Nowpakahok and Merle Apassingok have their own homes, the session believed the manse to be an ideal place for people needing to quarantine. At press time, three Gambell residents were quarantining in the Gambell Presbyterian manse.

Please keep the church, its leadership, and the whole community in prayer as they continue to take the steps needed to stop the spread of this virus on St. Lawrence Island. Pray also for the many other communities affected across Alaska, and across the world.

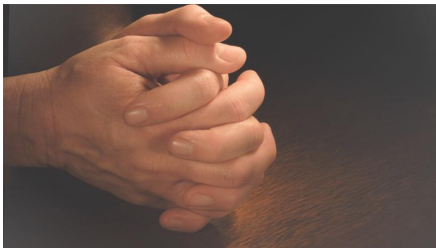
## PHS: A Conversation on Black Theology
