Trauma Recovery Hotline

Help with trauma recovery is a phone call away

Recent events in the news can affect people in a very personal way. Sometimes intense emotions are triggered or long-buried memories of a past trauma resurface. Breaking the silence and finding help can be difficult.

The confidential Employee Assistance Program, administered by Cigna Behavioral Health, can be a valuable source of support. Ministers and employees who have the Board's medical coverage and anyone in their household may call the Board's dedicated EAP line, 866-640-2772, for help.

- Consultations of 20-30 minutes with a licensed professional can provide immediate support and identify next steps.
- Up to six face-to-face counseling sessions in a safe, supportive environment are provided at no cost to you.

Whether you are struggling with a trauma you have experienced or are supporting someone else's recovery, assistance is available 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
